

# *Roxbury Historic District Commission*

17 February 2010

Firehouse: C. Haver, G. Miller and J. Huber volunteered to monitor the C of A. When the project is ready to begin, a schedule for the monitors will be established.

Roxbury Market: W. Walker spoke to the deli owner who had not been given any information from R. Bermann re: the approved fence. The owner will come before the HDC with a new application at the next meeting. HDC members will look at the fence there now and J. Huber will take a few photographs for that meeting.

Barn Survey: R. Carley has completed the survey. She provided the HDC with a disc of the text and one for the photos. A complete copy was made of the survey sheets for the HDC. She will hand deliver the survey to Hartford and when the Town submits the receipts, the grant will be closed. The HDC will then apply for a matching grant for design, photos, editing, etc.

Barn book: J. Huber brought a sample of the layout of the book. R. Stevenson agreed to provide introductory paragraphs for the interview sections. The HDC discussed options for funding the publication.

Architecture books: The HDC approved the purchase of two books to add to our library.

Projects: The list of proposed projects for the HDC was handed around. R. Stevenson suggested that we add the farmer's journal in the Hodge Collection to the list.
