

ROXBURY RECREATION COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING - FEBRUARY 24, 2010  
MINUTES

Meeting called to order at 7:02 pm by Chairman, Andy Engel.

Members in attendance: Lisa Easter, Patricia Steed, Andy Engel, Karen Puskas, Jennifer Benner and Mark Lowe. Members excused: Missy Cole and Kathleen Garafolo. Members absent: Bill Petruno.

Summer Camp 2010

The Commission spoke about the structure of camp for the summer of 2010. Pat discussed the results of the online survey the Commission put together and sent out to Booth School parents. Out of the 67 households the Commission sent the survey to, 14 responded. The Commission agreed that this was not a suitable amount of responses to gather enough information to draw any conclusions from at this time. The survey included questions about summer camp in the past and what parents and campers liked, disliked, wanted to see more of, less of, etc. The Commission will continue to keep the survey open over the next couple of months and monitor the results and report back at a future meeting.

Lisa made a motion and Mark seconded it to talk about setting the hours for summer camp.  
Discussion:

The Commission spoke of several possible time frames, age brackets and dates. Cost and additional supplemental programming were also discussed.

Lisa withdrew her original motion and made the following motion with Mark seconding it:  
The Commission accept the subsequent summer 2010 day camp structure and specifics:

1. Camp will operate 5, one week sessions from July 5 - August 6, 2010
2. The daily hours of camp will be 9:00 am - 1:00 pm
3. Camp will be offered to children entering grades Kindergarten through grade 5 as of September 2010.
4. Camp will operate with a director, activity leaders and counselors
5. The cost for camp for Roxbury residents will be \$99 per week, per camper. Campers registered after June 15, 2010, camp will be charged \$125 per week.
6. The Commission will also continue to investigate offering sports camps in the 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm time slot. Camps being considered are basketball, baseball, soccer, swimming and multi-sports. These would be offered at additional costs.

All in favor, motion passed unanimously.

Pat made a motion and Lisa seconded it that non-residents wishing to attend camp must pay an additional fee of \$25 per child, per week. All in favor, motion passed unanimously.

Karen made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Lisa seconded it. All in favor, motion passed unanimously.

Meeting adjourned at 8:45 pm.
